



Returning Women Students Scholarships Common Application Instructions

The goal of the Returning Women Students Scholarships is to support undergraduate students aged 25 and older in the completion of a first bachelor's degree so they can advance their careers after graduation. In additional to financial support through three different scholarships, the Returning Women Students Scholarships Program also offers a peer mentor program and various other support services and resources. Before completing this application for the 2015-2016 academic year, please make sure to review the scholarship criteria that are common for all three scholarships. Please also be mindful of the specific criteria required for each individual scholarship and include the additional information as necessary. The boxes below can also serve as a checklist for you prior to submitting your application packet.

	Must be a UMBC student, aged 25 or older, pursuing a <i>first</i> bachelor's degree
	Must have completed at least 60 credits
	Must be in good academic standing and have a GPA of at least 2.5
	Must be enrolled or planning to enroll part-time or full-time at UMBC during the academic year
	Must complete an online Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at the U. S. Department of
	Education's secure Web site, http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/ . In step 6 of the FAFSA, list UMBC
	Must include a transcript. See details in "required attachments" section below
	The essay portion of the application must be typed and satisfy all eligibility requirements to be considered

	Award amounts can vary anywhere between \$500-\$5000 based on individual need and merit for the academic year
	Notes on Recipient Selection:
	This is signature scholarship for the Women's Center's Returning Women Students Scholarship Program and each year a cohort of approximately 10-12 Newcombe scholars are selected. Eligible scholars are selected based on three overall components: (1) financial need, (2) other extenuating life situations that create additional need, and (3) clarity of educational and career goals. Scholarships are only available for the fall and spring semesters.

	Award amounts can vary anywhere between \$1000-\$4000 for the academic year; 2-4 students are awarded. Scholarships are only available for the fall and spring semesters.

	Applicant must be U.S. citizen
	Award amounts can vary anywhere between \$250-\$1000 for the academic year; 1-3 students are awarded. Scholarships are only available for the fall and spring semesters.

Scholars Program Requirement for All Scholarships Awardees:

- 1. If you are selected as a scholarship recipient, you will be required to sign the Women's Center Scholarship Agreement Form and any other additional forms required by the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarship before receiving the award.
- 2. Recipients will be required to write a thank you letter to the scholarship foundation describing how this award will impact their educational and career goals. Additional details will be included in the award letter. Failure to honor this requirement may result in forfeiture of the award.
- 3. Recipients will be required to write a short biography to be used for grant purposes. Additional instructions will be provided at a later date.
- 4. Students must agree to comply with the program requirements outlined in the Women's Center Scholarship Agreement Form. These requirements include:
 - a. Meeting one-on-one with a professional staff member at the Women's Center at least once a semester
 - b. Participating in the Returning Women Scholars Mentoring Program. Program requirements include:
 - i. Attending a 3-hour orientation prior to the fall semester and one other Returning Women Forum event throughout the fall semester; a spring orientation and 1 other meeting will be required in the spring.
 - ii. Meeting with your mentoring peer at least once a month
